March was **National Nutrition Month**, and 2-1-1 Brevard began gearing up to make referrals to Summer BreakSpot, where children can get free breakfasts and lunches while school is on break.

The state partners with 2-1-1's to share information about the May-August feeding sites. In 2012, almost 60,000 lunches and more than 24,000 breakfasts were served in Brevard.
